 - effectively **steward** taxpayer dollars on behalf of the American people.





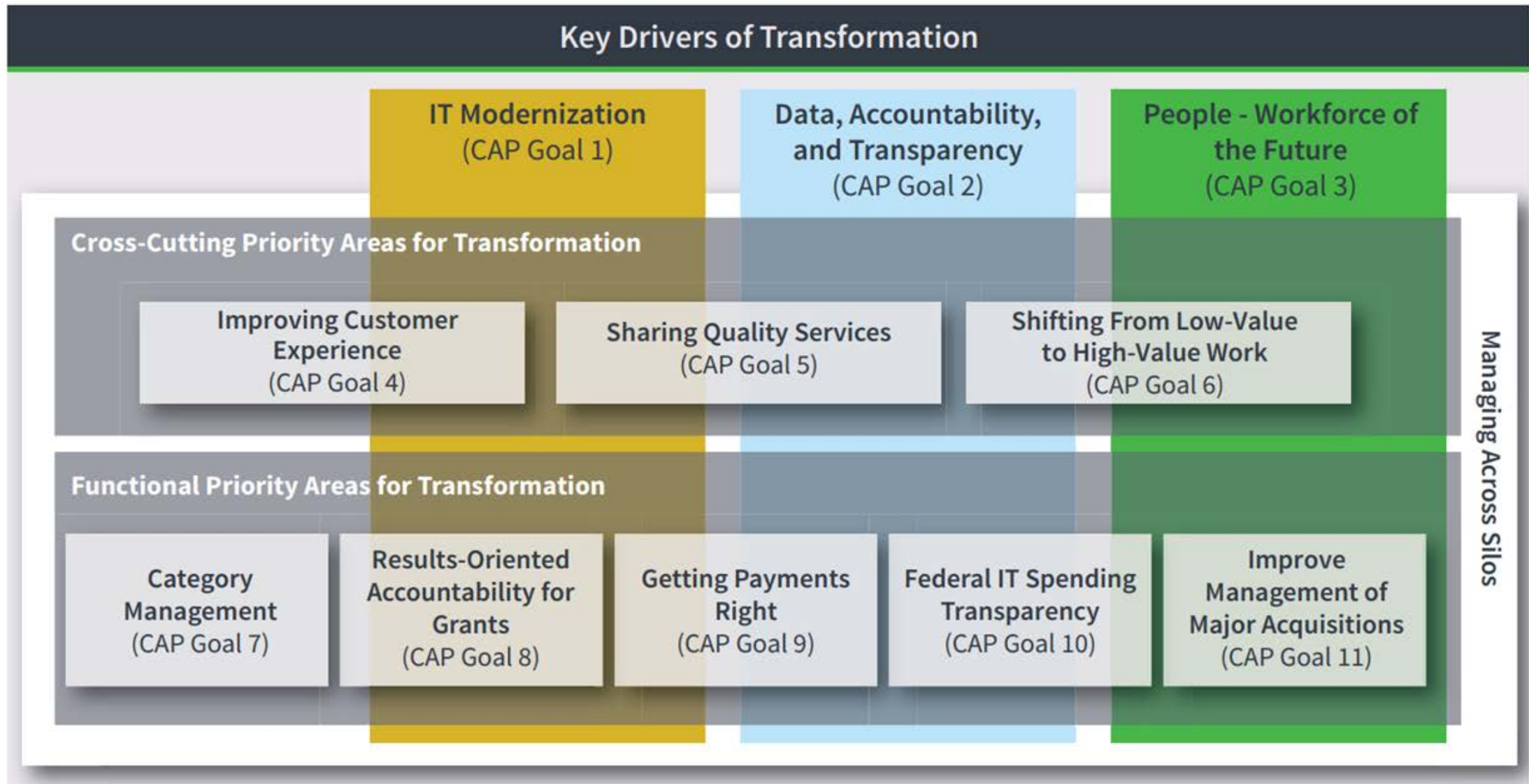
Key Drivers of Transformation
